Attacks that can come from a web download, a shared drive, or a file attached to a legitimate looking email

Almost any Microsoft Office document can be compromised to contain code, links, or even videos that covertly release malware, trojans, ransomware or even remote access software onto a system or network.



Most traditional anti-phishing email products won't identify an attack when it's downloaded via other types of files.
