
How Secure is Email?



(your ISP - internet service provider) the letter's evelope is taken off and copies are left behind. The post office (ISP) then puts your letter back in an envelope (TLS) and sends it to the receiving post office [3] (ISP) where

copies of the letter are made.

When your letter (email) arrives at its final location the envelope is removed by the computer's settings [4] for the user to view [5].
