When you don't recognize the package,
the QR code might be the threat



- Beware of packages you didn't ask for, especially when the sender info is missing.
- Fraudsters place QR-code stickers on packages or delivery notices and trick you into scanning them.
- Scanning may lead to phishing, malware or your identity being used.
- When in doubt – **don't scan**. Report suspicious deliveries and protect your privacy.
